Ways Parents Can Be Involved



PRAY

Most Christian parents are already praying for their students. Here are a few more ways you can pray and encourage others to pray:

- Pray for the entire school and cooperation among the Body of Christ to impact the school for the Gospel.
- Join or start a Moms In Prayer group (MomsInPrayer.org).
- Encourage your congregation to pray for the schools and students.
- Ask your church to commission First Priority Student Leaders as missionaries.

PROMOTE

Parents can be the greatest cheerleaders for their students!

- Share the vision and strategy of First Priority with your friends, your church and your co-workers.
- Connect First Priority to your church by introducing a First Priority staff member to your pastor or missions committee.
- Make sure your church body knows what HOPE Cycle week it is and what students in your church are doing to reach their campus with the gospel.

PARTICIPATE

- Occasionally attend a First Priority meeting to observe how students are leading and sharing their faith.
- Attend monthly First Priority Team Planning Meetings.
- Volunteer to serve out outreach events.
