

GOSPEL PRESENTATION: T.U.R.N.T.

Totally Un-condemned and Remade New Today

Today, I'm sharing some good news with you. No matter what you have done or what you have been through, there is HOPE. Let me tell you about it.

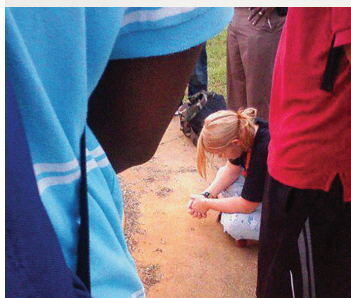
- **TOTALLY** pure and perfect, God created the world to be a place of beauty and meaning. He created each of us with purpose and identity. God has designed every person you see in this room. God's good creation was broken when sin entered the world. Sin is anything – thought, word, action or attitude – that doesn't meet God's standard of perfection (we call that 'holiness' in the Bible). Our independence separated us from God and our sin made it TOTALLY impossible to have a relationship with Him. And sin isn't just wrong stuff we do – it's inside us. We can never be good enough to get rid of it. Sin also carries a price tag with it – death (**Romans 6:23**).
- **UNCONDEMNED** because God's Son took on our guilt and punishment, there is HOPE for you and me. God loves us - He didn't want us to be separated from Him. John 3:16 tells us what God did to bridge the gap between our sin and His holiness: *"For God loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."* Jesus paid for the wrong that you have done, are doing, and will do in the future. He paid for it by dying on the cross and taking the punishment that you and I deserve. God the Father also raised Him from death - and His life offers to us the hope of eternal, never-ending life.
- **REMADE** and restored is what God wants your life to be. He wants a relationship with you. He has removed the obstacle of sin and is inviting you today to accept the sacrifice Jesus made for you. We accept that by believing in the sacrifice and confessing Jesus as our Lord.

- **NEW** life begins when you make Jesus your Lord and Savior. Romans 10:9 says that if you want to be saved, you must “confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him [Jesus] from the dead.” You must believe this by faith. This is only the beginning, though; as following Jesus is something you choose to do daily.
- **TODAY**, you can begin a relationship with God. You don’t have to schedule an appointment with God or set a future goal to make yourself acceptable to Him. You can turn to God right now, just as you are - trusting Him to do the work of salvation in you..

HOW TO RECEIVE CHRIST AS SAVIOR

1. Confess your need (I am broken and in sin)
2. Change your direction in life, knowing that God’s way of living is better than our way of living
3. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and was raised to life to save you and restore your relationship to God
4. Receive through prayer the free gift of salvation and begin your journey as part of the family of God.



WHAT TO PRAY

Father God,

I know that I am broken, and I need your forgiveness. Jesus, I believe you died and were raised so I could be saved. I want to turn away from my old life and toward a completely new life with You in Your family. Right now, I put my trust in You and invite You to come into my life and change it. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
